"Tennessee Twilight"


This is a painting of a landscape for a client who grew up in Tennessee but now resides in Texas. In their new home, they're placing my artwork in a spot where they can see it every day.

The challenge for me was getting the lighting correct as they wanted me to capture the last light of the day - that moment just before the day's light disappears entirely. There's so much power and magic in those few minutes when the sun is slowly closing its door on the day--giving us time to rest and quiet in gratitude. I think I did it!




